We are seeking an experienced, dynamic individual who will work part-time under the direction of the executive board as overall editor and manager of the New Hampshire News Collaborative. The editor will report to the executive board, which is comprised of one representative from each project participant. The editor's duties will include: Plan and coordinate with the executive board how to best select, produce, time, promote and share the work of diverse media and stakeholders and vet the stories for quality with a focus on using a solutions journalism approach. The editor will work with board members and reporters to ensure a vibrant, creative flow of ideas and stories, always generating enthusiasm for the project among participants and in the community. The editor will also be responsible for planning and hosting public events that will be held as part of the news gathering and public education about the Collaborative's work. The editor will be responsible for creating an exciting, respectful, innovative workplace that encourages excellence in all phases of news production. The editor will serve as the liaison to SJN if any questions arise. This individual must be an excellent communicator and manager and be able to troubleshoot with the board any problems that might arise.
