

## **Collaborations Manager**

Reveal from The Center for Investigative Reporting has been a pioneer over the last decade in nurturing newsroom collaborations to expand the scope, reach and impact of investigative reporting. We're seeking a dynamic team player to help us develop and manage local and national collaborations in communities across the country.

The Collaborations Manager will lead our growing Reveal Local Labs initiative and will oversee a few other key editorial collaborations that demonstrate our commitment to increasing the volume of and capacity for local investigative reporting.

We are launching the Local Labs in four regions over the next two years, fostering community collaborations to jointly produce high-impact investigations for local and national audiences on a variety of platforms and engaging with the public in creative ways. The first two Local Labs are underway in San Jose and New Orleans. The Collaborations Manager will lead management of these sites and the process to select the next two communities. The person in this position will work alongside our community engagement manager to create lasting relationships between local news organizations, the communities they serve and Reveal.

The Collaborations Manager will oversee investigative training and project execution, develop a system to foster smooth communication among all parties, advise the investigative process and track progress on projects. This will include serving as the primary conduit between Reveal and external newsroom partners to coordinate contracts, publication dates, crediting, cross promotion and award entries. The Collaborations Manager will work with staff from Reveal and the local newsroom partners to edit, design and distribute stories, ensuring they reach diverse audiences, and to measure and document the work's impact.

Candidates should have at least five years of experience in journalism with a proven track record of team building, preferably with multi-platform production and community engagement expertise. The ideal candidate will also have a background in investigative or data journalism.
